Approximately 150 executives (commonly known as 147 group) were declared passed in the said examination & accordingly, they were promoted to SDE(T) grade in 2005 onwards on different dates under 1/3rd Quota. However, the seniority and subsequent Promotion granted to these LDCE executives were challenged in various courts. Since, there was an interim protection on disputed Seniority of 147 group executives in the grade of SDE, they were granted subsequent promotions also with due respect to the pending litigation before Hon'ble Courts, at that time.

As per Judgement of Hon'ble Kerala High Court, a candidate should complete 5 years of regular Service in feeder Cadre (JTO) as on 1st January of a Vacancy Year for making him/her eligible.

3. Hence, in accordance with the above said Judgment, the seniority list in SDE grade w.r.t. these executives has been revised and circulated vide this office letter dtd. 06.06.2018 against vacancy year 1994-95 to 1996-97 (Upto 22.7.1996) under 1/3 quota as per RR 1981 and subsequent modification thereof to eligible executives.

4. 


