We learn that the COS will be meeting on 28th September 2012 to consider DoT note proposing further extension of deputation

of the Group A officers of DoT who have not opted for absorption in BSNL and are to be relieved back to DoT before 30th

September 2012 as per orders of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. If DoT's proposal is approved, it will be a case of around

1600 and odd officers managing the affairs of BSNL remaining permanently on deputation from 1.10.2000, when the 3 lakhs and

odd officers and employees have taken permanent absorption in BSNL. This will set a bad precedent, will be against existing

DoPT and DPE guidelines and will be violation of Article 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India. All the BSNL absorbed
