R/Sir,


We are sorry to say, but now it becomes the practice of BSNL Management not to pay the salary of their employees in time. Once again, we, as a result of this, convey the deep disappointment and resentment in the minds of BSNL employees over non-payment of their salary for May 2020 till today. While, BSNL employees have been rendering unflinching telecom services during the lockdown, risking their lives, is quite appalling.

2. After a reduction in the employee's strength by more than 50%, bringing the expenditure towards salary to half the previous amount, there cannot be any excuse about the non-availability of funds. Management should have ensured that the employees who are shouldering the huge workload now, due to 80000 employees have already taken VRS, should be paid in time. Not getting salary in time is not only a question of the survival of employees but also a question of their self-esteem. Delaying the payment of the salary further will have an unpleasant impact on the morale of BSNL employees, which does not augur well for BSNL.

3. We, therefore, request that all efforts may be made for payment of salary for May 2020 immediately.
